SEWER USERS AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into between the **Enlarged Hepzibah Public Service District**, a public and political subdivision of the State of West Virginia, hereinafter referred to as the **“Owner”** and _____ hereinafter referred to as **“User.”**

***** WITNESSITH *****

WHEREAS, the **User** desires to purchase **sewer** from the **Owner** and to enter into a **sewer users agreement**, as required by the Rules and Regulations of the **Owner**.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and agreements herein contained, it is hereby understood and agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

The **Owner** shall furnish, subject to the limitations set out in its Rules and Regulations now in force or as hereinafter amended, **sewer service** to the following described property:

The **User** agrees to, and does herewith, **pay a tap fee of \$350.00 (Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars)** to the **Owner**.

The **User** agrees to grant to the **Owner**, its successors and assigns a perpetual easement in, over, under and upon the above-described land as necessary and required for the purpose of **ingress** to and **egress** from or otherwise provide **sewer service** to the above-described lands. Such easement gives to the **Owner** the right to erect, construct, install and lay, and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace and remove sewer pipelines and appurtenant facilities.

The **User** shall install and maintain at his/her own expense a service line which shall begin at the **sewer tap** and extend to the dwelling or place of use. The service line shall connect with the sewer system of the **Owner** at the sewer tap, provided the **Owner** has determined in advance that the system is of sufficient capacity to permit delivery of **sewer** at the point.

The **User** agrees to comply with and be bound by the Rules and Regulations of the **Owner** and of the **Public Service Commission of West Virginia**, now in force, or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended or changed. The **User** also agrees to pay for sewer at such rate, time and place as shall be determined by the **Owner** and agrees to the imposition of such penalties for noncompliance as are now set out in the **Owner's** and Public Service Commission's Rules and Regulations, or which may be hereafter adopted and imposed by the **Owner**. The rate structure for sewer use will be established and approved by the **Owner** or the **West Virginia Public Service Commission**, as legally applicable, and published as a tariff. Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations and rate structure tariffs are available for inspection at the **Owner's** office.

The **Owner** shall have final authority in any question of location of any service line connection to its sewer system, and may terminate service to a **User** who allows a connection of an extension to be made of the service line for the purpose of supplying **sewer service** to another **user**.

The **User** shall connect his/her service lines to the **Owner's** sewer system and shall commence to use the **sewer system** on or within sixty (60) days from the date the **sewer service** is made available to the **User** by the **Owner**. **Sewer** charges to the **User** shall commence when the customer connects to the system or sixty (60) days from the **date service** is made available, whichever comes first, regardless of whether the **User** connects to the system.

The **User** hereby agrees to take service and pay at least the minimum **sewer bill** or the cost per sewer used based on the current **Sewer Tariff** for a period of **three (3) years** regardless of whether the **User** actually uses such service.

The failure of a customer to pay **sewer charges** duly imposed and rendered shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

1. Nonpayment within twenty (20) days from the billing date will be subject to a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the delinquent account.
2. Nonpayment within thirty (30) days from the billing date will result in the initiation of action to terminate service.
3. In the event it becomes necessary to terminate service, a reconnection fee as set forth in the tariff will be applicable.
